INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, **until, but not after 11:00 a.m., November 26, 1986**, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

Prime contractors interested in bidding on this project may receive one copy of the specifications and other bid documents at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to the bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "**BIDS ON RE-ROOFING AT THE WILLOW LAKE TREATMENT PLANT**", and show the name and business address of the bidders.

Any objections to or comments upon these specifications must be submitted in writing to the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302 not later than five (5) days prior to the bid opening.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidders will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been

awarded.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities and of postponing the award of the contract for thirty (30) days.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violations of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

NOTE: A site orientation will be held at the Willow Lake Sewage Treatment Plant, 5915 Window Island Rd. North, Salem, Oregon 97303, at 10:00 a.m., on November 12, 1986. Only one orientation will be held. The orientation is expected to last approximately three (3) hours.
