federal assistance under Section 9 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, is being sought. This funding is available from excess funding for Overhead Destination Signs (current budget: \$213,000; requested revised budget: \$168,000) in UMTA Project No. OR-90-0007.

No persons, families or businesses will be displaced by this project.

The project is in conformance with comprehensive land use and transportation planning in the area and will be programmed in the Transportation Improvement Program. A statement of Tri-Met's charter bus service is available for inspection at the Tri-Met's Administrative Offices. Tri-Met will not be engaging in school bus operations. Private transportation enterprise will not be directly affected by the project.

The project is currently under review by the state and district clearinghouses.

At the hearing, Tri-Met will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the projects.
