### Space Research Building Named After McNair

The Massachusetts Institute of Technology will name the building housing the MIT Center for Space Research for Dr. Ronald E. McNair, the MIT alumnus who was killed when the space shuttle Challenger crashed

last January. Dedication ceremonies are Dec. 5. The 20-year-old building, shown here is an architect's rendering, will be named the Ronald E. McNair Building. Dr. McNair was an MIT alumnus. He received the Ph.D. in physics in 1976.
