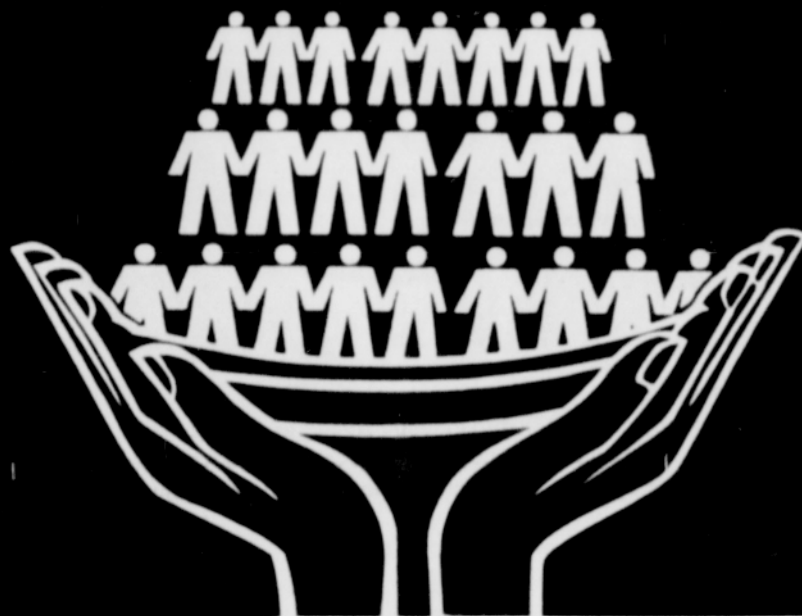

The Assault on Illiteracy Program Meets

The Assault on Illiteracy Program (A.O.I.P.) will hold its second meeting Sunday, January 11th at P.H. Masonic Temple, 116 N.E. Russell Street at 5:00 p.m.

The Assault on Illiteracy Program is a framework by which local Black community organizations—churches, NAACP, Urban League, Masons, Eastern Stars, Elks, Sororities, Fraternities, and other Black civic and social organizations—can work together to reduce the high rate of illiteracy. Almost half (47%) of Black adults age 18 and above are functionally illiterate.

The year 2000 has been set as the goal to completely eliminate illiteracy. We now have more than 90 national Black-led organizations working together under the banner of the A.O.I.P. to unify efforts and uplift our communities in reaching this goal.

Citizens, civic and social organizations of our community are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting for further information on the Assault on Illiteracy Program.

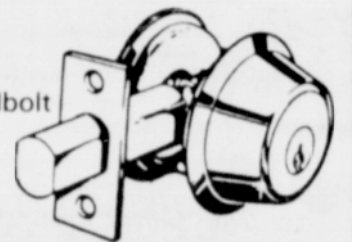
