# **Portland Superintendent** Joins Educators for National **Honors**

Matthew W. Prophet, Jr., superintendent of Portland Public Schools, joins 99 other North American school managers honored this year by "Executive Educator" magazine

The February issue of the Virginia-based publication for school professionals applauds the educators for "excellent leadership and outstanding professional achievements" in a blue-ribbon listing similar to the Fortune 500 and Forbes 400 for business and industry.


