Sealed proposals for the construction of the **Gaston West Trunk** will be received by the Unified Sewerage Agency of Washington County at 150 North First Avenue, Room 302, Hillsboro, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m. local time on **March 26, 1987**, and then will be publicly opened and read.

The work consists of the construction of approximately 3,352 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer line, 75 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer line, 11 manholes, 1 bored undercrossing, and miscellaneous appurtenances.

Contract documents may be examined and obtained at the office of the Unified Sewerage Agency, 150 North First Avenue, Hillsboro, Oregon, for a \$10 nonrefundable fee.

This project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The contract will be subject to regulations of the Departments of Labor, and Housing and Urban Development. Attention is called to Federal provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, HUD Section 3 requirements, and the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the contract documents.
