Pre-registration is necessary since class size is limited. Cost of the class is \$20 per couple or individual to cover materials. Call the American Red Cross 284-7090 to pre-



Law Foundation Awarded Funds

The Oregon Law Foundation (QLF) has awarded funds to several law related charitable programs in Multnomah County, according to OLF president Linda Bergman

Multnomah County Legal Aid, which provides legal assistance to the disadvantaged, will receive \$69,000, part of a \$300,000 grant to the Association of Oregon Legal Aid Programs. Multnomah Bar Association Volunteer Lawyers Project was granted \$15,000, St. Andrew Legal Clinic will receive \$20,000, and Northwestern School of Law will receive \$10,000.

Funds granted to other law-related charitable programs were: \$8,000 to Immigration Counseling Service, \$8,000 to the Bicentennial Mock Trial Competition for high school students, \$4,000 to the Minority Bar Exam Passage Program, \$10,000 to Minority Scholarship Program, Inc.

The grants, which total \$350,000, are intended to assist minorities, immi-

grants, students, and the poor The OLF grants are awarded twice-yearly, in January and July. Since its establishment in 1981 by the Oregon State Bar, OLF has awarded \$1,215,430 to various public service and educational programs. Grant funding comes from donations to the Oregon Lawyers' Endowment for Public Service and from the Lawyers' Trust Accounts Program.




