## DEAN HERFF COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING MEMPHIS STATE UNIVERSITY

Memphis State University and its Herff College of Engineering are at an exciting time of transition. The College has recently broadened its program to include doctoral studies as part of the University's overall growth of academic programs.

The applicant for the deanship must have an earned doctorate in an engineering discipline and be eligible for appointment as a full professor in the college. The applicant should have appropriate management skills, a strong academic background, a proven record of research and teaching, and the ideas and enthusiasm to lead the college.

Memphis State University, one of Tennessee's two comprehensive state universities, has 7 schools and colleges which offer degrees in more than 60 undergraduate disciplines and nearly 100 graduate disciplines. Its 21,000 students, including over 4000 graduate students, come from all 50 states and many foreign countries. The suburban campus is only a few minutes drive from any part of Memphis, a thriving metropolis of nearly one million persons that offers a moderate cost of living and a wide range of lifestyles, entertainment, and cultural activities.

The Herff College of Engineering offers undergraduate and graduate programs in civil, electrical, and mechanical engineering, and engineering technology along with a master's program in industrial systems engineering. All of the undergraduate programs are ABET accredited. A doctoral program will be initiated in September, 1987. The college's 60 faculty members serve approximately 1800 undergraduate and 200 graduate students. Among the major responsibilities of the new dean will be the implementation of the doctoral program and the expansion of the college's sponsored research activities while maintaining excellence in its undergraduate programs. In addition, the dean will be expected to play a major role in the development of new biomedical engineering programs in conjunction with the University of Tennessee, Memphis.

Memphis State University is committed to finding a dynamic and dedicated individual to lead its Herff College of Engineering and is prepared to offer a salary commensurate with his/her credentials. The position will become available during the summer of 1987. Initial screening of the applicants will begin on April 1, 1987 and will continue until the position is filled.

Upon receipt of the Applications, Tillamook County will review the applications and award the franchise in accordance with Tillamook County Ordinance No. 4, Article IV, "FRANCHISING OF SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL."

Tillamook County may choose to not award a solid waste disposal franchise, upon a finding that it is not in the public interest to do so.
