The YWCA of Portland's Girls' Emancipation Program will sponsor an all-day workshop entitled "Teaching Kids To Succeed with Self, Others, in School and on the Job", Thursday, April 30, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., in the gymnasium of the YWCA of Portland, 1111 SW 10th (223 6281), to help other counselors, teachers and parents learn how to train youth to function more effectively socially, emotionally and academically.
