**Leodis V. McDaniel
 Madison Principal, Dies of
 Heart Attack**

Leodis V. McDaniel, 51, principal of Madison High School since 1983, died early Saturday morning in Bessie Kaiser Medical Center after suffering a heart attack. He became ill at home about midnight Friday after attending a gathering earlier in the evening with friends.
 Mr. McDaniel, a North Portland resident, was born in Arkadelphia, Ark. He moved to Portland as a youth and graduated from Lincoln High School in 1953. He received a bachelor's degree in science education in 1957 from Portland State University.
 In 1970, Mr. McDaniel obtained a master's degree in education from Oregon State University.
 His first teaching position was at MacLaren School in Woodburn in 1957 as a counselor. In 1969, he left Woodburn and joined the Portland School District as a counselor at the old Adams High School.
 In 1974, he joined Madison High School as a counselor and was named acting vice principal there in 1977. Two years later, he was made vice principal, a position he held until becoming principal in 1983.
 He was a member of the Oregon Association of High School Principals, the Wellington Park Lions Club, the National Association of School Principals and the OSU and PSU alumni associations. He also was a member of the board of directors of the Portland Teachers' Credit Union.
 Surviving are his wife, Arnetta, a daughter, Fawn McDaniel of Portland; a son, Derric of Portland; and a sister, Barbara Peters of Portland. The funeral was held Thursday, April 16, at Bethel AME Church.
