Portland State University invites applications and nominations for position of Director of Minority Affairs.

The University, part of the Oregon State System of Higher Education (O.S.S.H.E.), is located in downtown Portland, and enrolls 16,000 students including the largest proportion of minority students in the state.

The University offers a number of academic programs at both the undergraduate and graduate level.

Position

The Director of Minority Affairs will report directly to the Vice President for Student Affairs, and will have budgetary and administrative responsibilities for minority student affairs. This new position requires the ability to deliver effective support services, programs and projects to enhance services for minority students.

Qualifications

A Masters Degree from an accredited institution in education, counseling or related field. The successful applicant will have a minimum of 3 years experience in working with non-traditional, culturally diverse student groups, preferably in a college or univer-

sity setting. The Director must possess excellent verbal and communications skills and the ability to promote the successful operation and coordination of the program throughout the University. Experience in program administration and community relations.
