Lesia is a graduate of Grover Cleveland High School and the daughter of Mrs. Laura Ali, also of Portland.



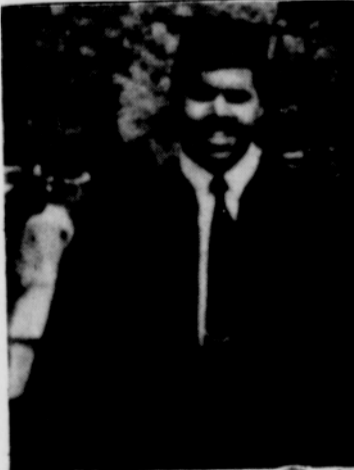
Atoa Brown
