PP&L Invites Customers to New Office

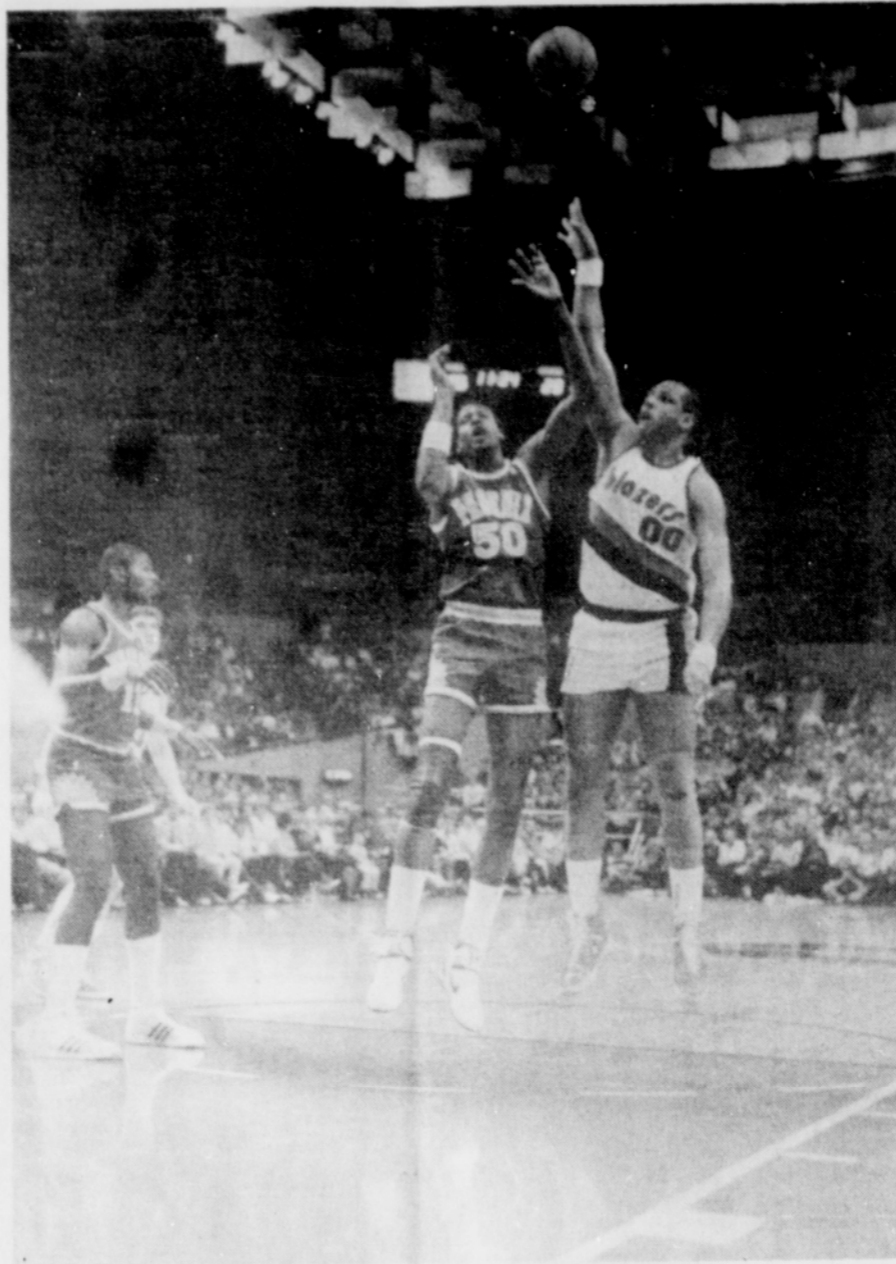
