REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Portland Development Commission (PDC) is soliciting proposals from qualified consultants to prepare plans for secondary roadways and recreation, and to prepare development guidelines for the Columbia South Shore Urban Renewal Area.

Considerable contact with developers, property owners, and public officials will be needed. A strong team of landscape architects, transportation planning/engineering and recreation planners is required.

The Portland Development Commission encourages participation of Minority/Women Business Enterprise contractors in its projects. The established Commission goals for participation is nine percent (9%) for Minority Business Enterprises and nine percent (9%) for Women Business Enterprises.

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Final Planning Completed

Final planning documents on a \$28 million office complex were signed recently in Portland between Gulf Oil Company of Nigeria and an international joint venture partnership, Yost Grube Hall, Portland, and FMA Architects, Lagos, Nigeria. FMA is the largest locally owned architectural firm in Nigeria.

The office complex, to be followed by a \$25 million housing development, will be used as company headquarters for all of Gulf's operations in Nigeria.

The project is situated on 50 acres of land on Nigeria's Lekki Peninsula, and will include a four-story office building with parking, annex and support facilities.

YGH is no stranger to Africa, having done extensive architectural and planning work in Khartoum, Sudan and the surrounding region. The firm has been involved in three agricultural research stations and two urban office towers in the north African country of 18 million people.

A new YGH project in Sudan is the planning and design of a new national archives building in the capital city of Khartoum.
