DEMOLITION & SITE CLEARANCE

Bids Due 2:00 pm, Sept. 1

The PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION will receive sealed Bids for Demolition of buildings and structures and Site Clearance of one (1) commercial structure and site work in the Union Station Site Block W, Portland, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m., Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on the 1st day of September, 1987 at which time and place all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract Documents, including Drawings and Specifications, are on file at the office of the PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, at 1120 S.W. Fifth Avenue, Ste. 1102, Portland, Oregon 97204-1968.

All bidders must comply with the provisions of Chapter 279 Oregon Revised Statutes relating to the qualification of bidders. The bidder's prequalification statement shall be prepared and presented on the City of Portland Prequalification Application and filed with the Portland City Engineer not later than nine (9) business days prior to the bid opening time.

A certified check or cashier's check payable to the order of the PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and acceptable Surety, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Con-

tract Documents must be paid on the project, and that the contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin, and that the contractor must comply with all provisions required by ORS 279.348 through ORS 279.356.

To assure compliance with the PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION'S Resolution No. 3455, Exhibit "A", MBE/FBE Recruitment, only bids in compliance with these MBE/FBE requirements shall be considered responsive.

The PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the PORTLAND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of the bidders prior to awarding the contract.

Bidder shall be certified as an EEO Affirmative Action Employer as prescribed by Chapter 3.100 of the Code of the City of Portland.
