Nevertheless, they must be paid at least the minimum wage (\$3.35 an hour) for all hours worked, according to a fact sheet on Farmworkers and the Federal Wage and Hour Law, available from Labor Department's Office of Information and Public Affairs, Washington, D.C. 20210.
