




"Faces of Nicaragua"

#### **Parents Staying Active at Emanuel**

An Active Parenting class is offered at Emanuel Hospital & Health Center for parents of children ages 2 through 18. It is sponsored by the Child Development Department.

Active Parenting is an innovative, video-based program designed to enhance child/parent relationships. In this six-part series of two-hour sessions, emphasis is focused on understanding child behavior, developing the child's sense of responsibility and winning cooperation.
