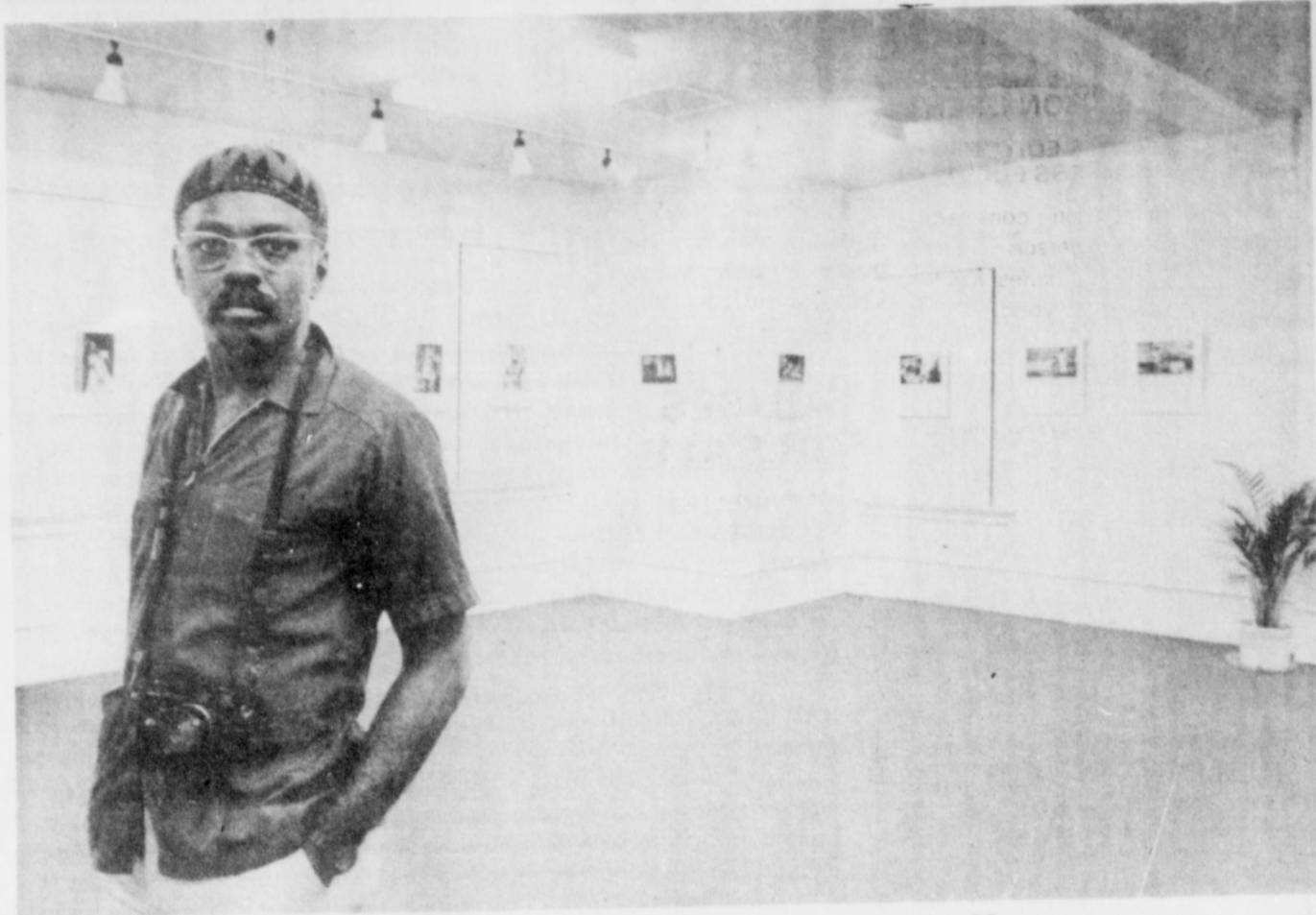

"Faces of Nicaragua"

The IFCC presents "Faces of Nicaragua", photography by Richard J. Brown, October 6-31, 1987. This exhibit will include black and white photographs of the people in Nicaragua. Brown traveled to Nicaragua as a representative of the Portland Rainbow Coalition in 1985.

The exhibit reflects Brown's commitment to portraying people as they are. Avoiding stereotypes, and the "blood and gut" photos typical of photographic reports from war-torn countries, his humanistic approach to his subjects results in profoundly moving photographs which enable people to remain open enough to question the circumstances surrounding the people he depicts.

Parents Staying Active at Emanuel


