

# Oregon Child Support Program

**1976** CSP began using the SOIL (Set-Off of Individual Liability) program of Oregon's Department of Revenue, to collect past-due child support that had been assigned to the state for reimbursement of ADC benefits. Under SOIL, CSP collects assigned arrearages by attaching state tax refunds claimed by absent parents owing the arrearages. This became a model for federal legislation in 1982.

**1981** CSP implemented its computerized "Support Enforcement System" (SES). SES provided an automated system for referring ADC absent parents to SED, and also gave SED an automated system for managing, tracking, and "working" cases.

**1982** The Federal government passed legislation allowing states to attach Federal tax refunds claimed by absent parents owing past-due support that had been assigned to reimburse ADC benefits. Oregon recovered over \$7,000 in ADC costs during the first year of this program.

**1984** The Federal government amended Title IV-D of the Social Security Act, establishing new guidelines and requirements for state child support enforcement programs. Under these new standards, state child support programs:

- must implement mandatory wage withholding for all employed parents who are more than one month delinquent in child support payments.
- Must use expedited procedures for establishing and enforcing support orders.
- Must expand the state income tax intercept process to include non-ADC cases as well as ADC.
- Must have procedures for imposing liens against real and personal property of absent parents who owe overdue support and own such property in the State.

### CLIENTS

The Oregon Child Support Program provides enforcement services to all applying non-ADC client-customers through county district attorneys. ADC client-customers receive enforcement services through the Support Enforcement Division of the Department of Justice. All client-customers receive payments, payment history and case data history services through the ad-

ministring office of the Child Support Program.

### BENEFITS

The Child Support Program encourages, assists, and enables families to become self-supporting. The program also reinforces the value that primary responsibility for supporting dependent children rests with their parents, not with Oregon's taxpayers.

The opening of a Job Corps recruitment office to serve Northeast Portland youth between the ages of 16 and 24 was announced Tuesday by David Nero, Chief Executive Officer of Nero and Associates.

Nero said the office, located at the King Neighborhood Facility, will serve young people in need of an opportunity to continue their education, learn a trade and become responsible, independent adults.

The Northeast location was selected based on the need of that area's young people to have easily accessible job training and job placement programs with an emphasis on educational pursuits.

Job Corps also teaches skills to the individual who may not ever have had a job. While learning a trade and on-the-job accountability, Job Corps students receive a clothing and expense allowance plus money that is put aside for their use after graduation.

A favorite slogan of individuals who have completed Job Corps training is, "Job Corps works and so do its graduates."
