Mr. Morris Edward Johnson was born in Portland on Nov. 1, 1961, and graduated from Jefferson High School in 1979. He was married to Yvonne Huegen of Heerlen, Netherlands on Jan. 5, 1988, and was the step-father of Sabrina and Ricardo.

Mr. Johnson joined the United States Army in 1981, and rose to the rank of sergeant. He was one of the finest non-commissioned officers and electronic equipment installer's in the Army. His conduct, his military bearing, and equipment installation abilities were unquestionable. He constantly proved himself and performed his duties in an outstanding professional manner. Mr. Johnson acquired a vast knowledge of procedures, policies, and techniques involved with the installation of electronic equipment, as was evidenced by his deployment of several duty assignments in Europe, Washington, D.C., and Korea, installing state-of-the-art communications equipment. 




