Sealed proposals for the Construction and Painting of Reservoir B-2 at S.W. Norwood Road will be received by the City of Tualatin (County of Washington, State of Oregon) until Thursday, November 3, 1988, at 2:00 p.m., local time, at the Tualatin City Offices, 18880 S.W. Martinazzi Avenue, Tualatin, Oregon 97062-0369 and then will be publicly opened and read. Bids will not be received after such date and time. The City Engineer, Michael McKillip, and the Civil Engineer, Michael Stone, are the persons designated to receive bids.

Major items of work include construction of reservoir B-2 (2.8 million gallons) including appurtenances and painting of the completed structure. Contract Documents may be examined at the office of the City Engineer, City Offices, Tualatin, Oregon. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the Tualatin City Offices, upon a deposit of Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00) for each document. The deposit will be refunded on the return of undamaged bid documents within ten (10) days after the bid opening.

Bidders must be prequalified with the City of Tualatin in compliance with Chapter 279 of Oregon Revised Statutes. Prequalification applications shall be filed no later than seven days prior to the bid opening date.

Proposals must be made upon the proposal forms bound in the Contract Documents and must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Tualatin (County of Washington, State of Oregon) in amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount bid.

Boones Ferry Road.
