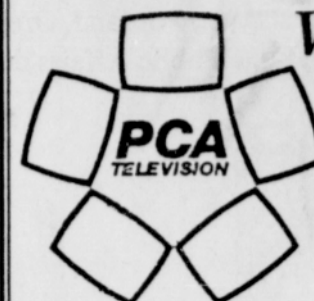

Where the white gleam of our bright star is cast.

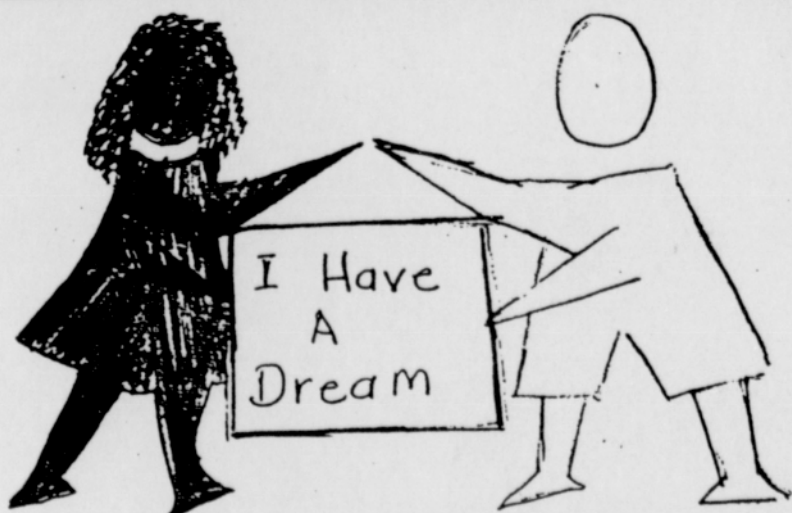
God of our weary years,
