Through the Homestead Program, PDC acquires vacant homes in need of repair and transfers them to qualified Homesteader. In turn, Homesteaders agree to make necessary repairs before moving in, accept a low-interest PDC home repair loan and live in the house for at least five years. There is no down payment involved in becoming a Homesteader. Homesteaders pay a one-time charge for taxes and insurance of \$500. In addition, PDC has low-interest loans available to pay for repairs.
