NURSING PROGRAM AWARDED \$1 MILLION

An innovative program designed to provide health care to the homeless in exchange for educational opportunities for students in the Howard University College of Nursing has just received support in the sum of more than \$1 million.

The W.K. Kellogg Foundation has awarded the nursing school a three-year grant of \$1,040,520 to improve the health services for homeless at the 1,700-bed Federal City Shelter in Washington, D.C. The grant will also fund education and training for volunteer staff who work at the shelter.

Specifically, the Kellogg grant will extend health promotion, maintenance and convalescent services to the homeless men and women at the Federal City Shelter through a nurse-managed health care delivery model involved collaboration among nurses, shelter staff, nursing educators, nursing students and other health professionals.

For nearly two years, students in Howard's College of Nursing have been gaining experience in caring for the homeless as part of the clinical nursing courses at the shelter's infirmary.

Howard nursing instructor Bernardine Lacey, who was instrumental in establishing the health facility at the shelter, notes that students are giving the homeless health care "with some measure of hope." Says Lacey, "They need these young peopletheir bright faces and caring attitudes..."

Among the objectives of the threeyear project are to develop a nursing infrastructure at the shelter that will provide continuous 24-hour health care in the infirmary. Dean Powell says undergraduate and graduate nursing students who will work in the infirmary will benefit from a

variety of "experiential learning and research opportunities for analysis of health problems facing the homeless."

less."
Adds Powell, "The project also plans to train selected homeless individuals to provide basic health care services at the shelter as a means of acquiring marketable skills."




