The Commissary Service required is for a 150 bed minimum security correctional facility. Briefly, the service is described as an off site commissary providing commercially produced and packaged candy, snack foods, personal hygiene products, cigarettes, and other miscellaneous consumer items through a weekly order delivery system.
