Take Six--Most Sought After Group In Gospel: With the tremendous success of Take Six's self-titled debut, which went gold, the group is one of the most sought after groups in gospel music. However, many like Rev. James Cleveland consider their group to be "more entertainment oriented, than gospel-oriented." That doesn't bother manager Gail Hamilton. "Our mission is to reach people who have not necessarily embraced Jesus. Not the Christian who has already identified and I don't think that's a sell-out. It's a way of packaging the ministry to people who would not ordinarily embrace this message...that Jesus is Lord and God is love. We were at the Playboy Jazz Festival and to listen to thousands of people singing. If we ever needed the Lord, we sure do need him now. It was great. I thought I knew the Lord before, but lately he has become really real, because I am really witnessing now. It's real easy for Christians to talk about Jesus to each other, but it's something else to talk to someone who has put it on the shelf or is not interested anymore. That's the challenge". The group just wined down a three-month long tour with Al Jarreau. They are presently at work on a second album.

Has Rev. Clay Evans lost interest in gospel music? Hard to believe but for all his accolades, concert requests and awards (most recently male vocalist of the year at Rev. Cleve-

land's Gospel Music Workshop), it's getting harder and harder to get Rev. Clay Evans to sing these days. Said Evans, "I don't want people to see me as a singing preacher. I'm a preacher who happens to sing, pray, counsel, and teach. And my longest stick now is preaching and teaching. It's just that simple."

NATIONAL MARCH FOR HOUSING

Oregon Housing Now! is gearing up for the National March For Housing in Washington D.C. October 7. Organizers are expecting over a million people to demand an end to homelessness through the restoration of funds for federal housing programs.

Transportation to the Capitol for Oregon marchers is needed. Local homeless persons who wish to demonstrate, but are financially unable to, are sending out a plea for gas funds and car pools. The response of Congress has been to fund emergency measures that accommodate but do not eliminate homelessness. Laws, such as the

McKinney Act, aid the needy but do not address the root cause of a serious national problem: the shortage of affordable housing.

The week of events will begin October 5th at the Pentagon. Participants will camp there in protest of the disproportionate amount of funds which go to military instead of human needs spending. On the 5th and 6th, Oregonians will join with many others to visit Congress and express to elected officials the concerns that have brought them from all around the nation.

Then on Saturday, October 7th, they will come together at the U.S. Capitol in Washington, D.C. to raise one voice with one message for the restoration of housing funds to the Federal budget: End the threat and the terrible reality of homelessness now through the creation of safe, decent, affordable homes for all our people.
