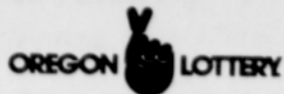

Speaker Willie Brown To Keynote Black Women's Physician's Eighth Annual Fall Benefit

The Association of Black Women Physicians (ABWP) will hold its Eight Annual Fall Benefit themed, "Honoring our Past, Investing in our Future," Saturday evening, October 28, 1989 at the Biltmore Hotel in Los Angeles. The black tie optional affair begins with a 6:30 p.m. reception and dinner at 7:30 p.m.

Dr. Anita Mitchell, president of ABWP, stated, "Our membership is extremely delighted to welcome Speaker Willie L. Brown, Jr. as Keynote for our benefit. He is not only one of the most erudite and charismatic orators in the country, he is also a respected and influential leader.

Under Mr. Brown's Speakership, California has enacted major reforms in the Medi-Cal system. He has authored several landmark medical bills including legislation establishing the Child Health Disabilities Program. Presiding over the evening's proceedings as Mistress of Ceremonies, will be Ms. LaRita Shelby, radio personality of KGFJ-AM in Los Angeles. Entertainment will be provided by The Fantasia Band.

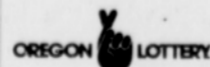
