

PCC Board Awards Contract For Library Books
The board of directors of Portland Community College has approved the award of a \$250,000 contract for a supplemental library book collection to Baker & Taylor Books, Commerce, GA.
A total of 6,967 books will be added to PCC library collections in humanities, science and technology, social and behavioral science, engineering and computers, medicine, service occupations and heavy industrial trades.
The acquisitions will be financed by \$150,000 raised in the PCC Foundation's 1989 annual fund campaign and \$100,000 which will be allocated from the college's general fund budget during the current and 1990 - 1991 fiscal years. National Organization Honors Local Consultants
The National Alliance of Black School Educators (NABSE) will honor the five local consultants who assisted in the organization and writing of the African-American Baseline Essays.
During the 17th Annual NABSE Conference, to be held here in Portland at the Hilton, the week of November 15, the local consultants will be honored. The five consultants are: Joyce Harris - Language Arts Essay; Janice Ingersol - Art; Janice Scroggins - Music; Kamau Anderson - Science; and McKinley Burt - Math.
In addition to the local consultants, two community organizations will be recognized for the contributions that members made to ensure that Portland developed a document of the highest quality and scholarship. The two organizations are the Portland Chapter of the Black United Front and the Desegregation and Monitoring Advisory Committee (DMAC).
