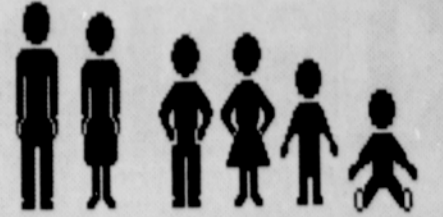




# RELIGION

Strengthen Your Faith Through Prayer And Regular Church Worship



On February 23, 1990, President Bush designated Arthur A. Fletcher as chairman of the Civil Rights Commission. The Civil Rights Commission consists of eight commissioners, four appointed by the President and four appointed by Congress.

**QUESTION:** I am disabled and getting Social Security benefits and Medicare. I am also a veteran, and my military service has entitled me to services from Veteran Administration doctors and hospitals. Two months ago, I went to a VA hospital for treatment of a condition not related to my military service. The VA charged me a co-payment fee. Can I get reimbursement from Medicare for the co-payment?

**ANSWER:** Medicare does not reimburse veterans for VA co-payments for services they receive in VA hospital and facilities, unless those services are emergency inpatient or outpatient hospital services. For outpatient hospital services, the Medicare payment is subject to the Medicare deductible and co-insurance amounts. Contact your Medicare intermediary or carrier for additional details.

**QUESTION:** My husband and I are applying for aged supplemental security income (SSI). We were told that our first month's check will be less than the others. Why is this?

**ANSWER:** SSI payments are prorated in the first month of eligibility from the date you filed. If your eligibility begins midway through the month, your first month's payment will be about half of your normal payment amount.

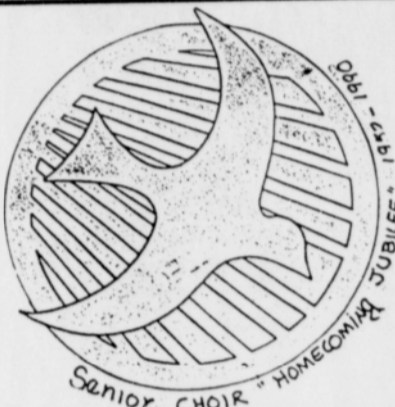

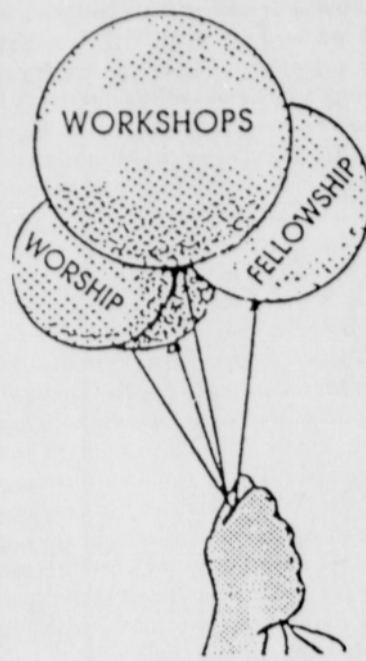
