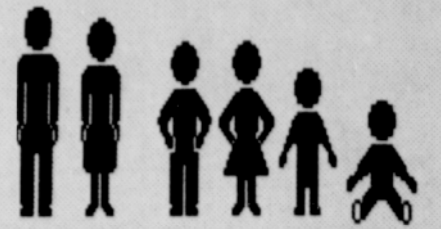

## Lighting The Torch of Conscience In Oregon

The Religious Community Confronts the Death Penalty

The Oregon Coalition to Abolish the Death Penalty will hold an observance which will bring together Oregon's religious leaders, and other justice leaders, to ceremoniously sign the "Lighting the Torch of Conscience" declaration. A march from the church to Oregon State Penitentiary will follow the observance to be held on: Sunday, April 29th at 3:00 p.m., First United Methodist Church, State and Church Streets, Salem, Oregon.

"Lighting the Torch of Conscience" is a nationwide campaign designed to rekindle the religious community's long-held commitment to the abolition of capital punishment and to provide people of faith with resources for study and action. Many peace and justice groups have sponsored this effort, including

the National Coalition to Abolish the Death Penalty, the National Interreligious Task Force on Criminal Justice, Amnesty International-USA, and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC).

The campaign was launched on April 14th, 1989 in Atlanta, Georgia when national leaders from religious communities and other organizations came together to sign the declaration. The campaign will culminate with a 330 mile march from Starke, Florida (site of Florida's death row) to inner city Atlanta, Georgia on May 5-19th.

As part of the Salem observance, OCADP will commission Scott Printz to participate in the march as Oregon's representative. Scott Printz is Chair of OCADP's Vigil Committee.
