Did You Know?

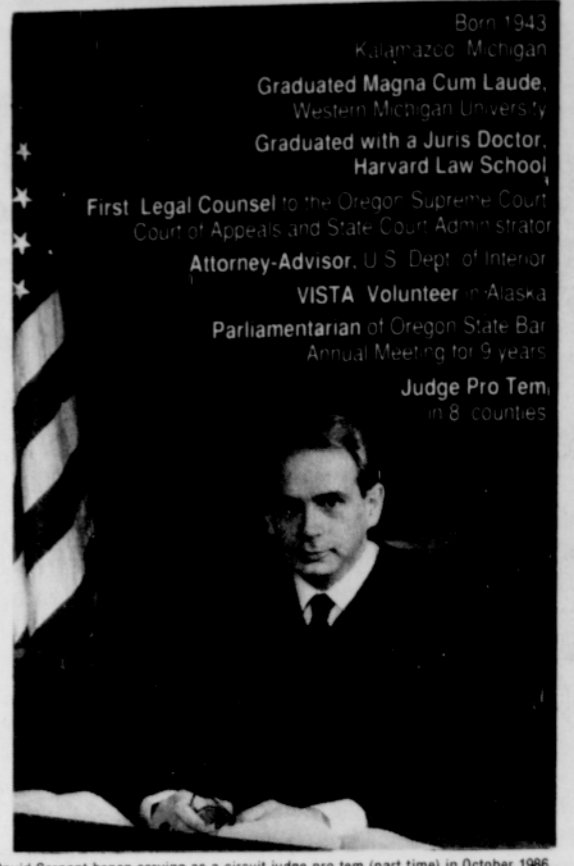

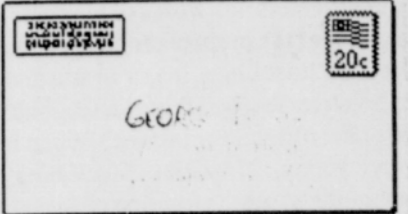
