THE INSPIRATIONAL SOUNDS



Several gospel presentations will be rendered by the **Inspirational Sounds** under the direction of Mr. John Gainer. This choir, of over 50 voices, has received national recognition and they hail from the heart of the Willamette Valley, Eugene, Oregon. This inter-denominational, community group strives to bring unity among various racial, cultural and ethnic constituents of our community through their performance of sacred Afro-American music; also, known as **Gospel Music**. In 1987, this exceptional group was one of four choirs, nationwide, that performed at the **Great American Gospel Gala**, in the fabulous Alice Tully Hall at the world renown Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts, in New York City.

THE SERMONETTES



The **Sermonettes of Portland** is a group of six female vocalists who began over 20 years ago--while singing in the church choir together. It was decided that they should expand their ministry in gospel music so that they could reach people outside of their church community. The Sermonettes felt that gospel music was another avenue by which they could share, with others, the joy and blessings that God had given them. This highly spirited resounding vocal group is under the direction of Mrs. Dorothy Davis.
