

### First-Time Emanuel Scholarships Awarded To N.E. Community Residents

When John Pham enters Oregon State University in the fall of 1990 to begin pre-med studies, he will be going with encouragement and a commitment from Emanuel Hospital & Health Center.

A joint effort by the Emanuel Medical Center Foundation and Emanuel Hospital & Health Center will result in four North/Northeast neighborhood residents receiving a \$1000 scholarship for each of their four years of college. The students are committed to pursuing a healthcare career. Pham, who lives on NE Ainsworth, currently has a 3.8 grade point average at Benson High School, is Treasurer of the National Honor Society and is an avid tennis player. He also spends time at the Veteran's Administration Medical Center, where he has learned about working in a hospital environment.

"I am exposed to many patients and I enjoy working with them. Helping someone that is sick or injured makes me feel like I am a part of the medical team. That makes me feel I

have contributed to the community," he said.

The scholarships are an outgrowth of an idea first developed by the hospital's Community Liaison Forum. Members of that group, made up of church, business, neighborhood and civic leaders, thought the establishment of a healthcare scholarship would be a positive signal to the community that the hospital was interested in helping local students. The original plan to have one scholarship was expanded to four when the Foundation offered to fund two scholarships, and challenged the Administration to match them. Other scholarship winners are David Trinh, N. Delaware St., from Woodrow Wilson High School; and from Benson High School, Jennifer Halvorson, NE 72nd, and David Nguyen, NE 27th.

Trinh, who plans a career in Pharmacy, will attend the University of the Pacific in Stockton, California. Halvorson and Nguyen will major in Pre-medicine at Linfield College and the University of Portland respectively.

### Three-Day Festival Sternwheeler/Gorge

The Sternwheeler Days Parade is scheduled for Saturday, June 16, to start at 11:00 a.m. at the Charburger and end on the Festival Grounds at the Port of Cascade Locks. Groups are coming from afar to participate in the Parade.

A Costume contest will be held. The Costumes will be in the 1890 period.

The famous Cascade Locks Museum will be open for our visitors.

The Sternwheeler will have Brunch Cruises on Saturday and Sunday at 10:00 a.m. and at 12:30 p.m. Reservations are required for the Brunch Cruises. The phone number for the reservations is (503) 374-8427.

A Gambler's Cruise on the Sternwheeler is scheduled for Friday and Saturday Night from 9:00 to 11:00 p.m. No reservation is needed for this event.
