Briefly, the project includes exterior repair of two (2) buildings. Work on the Art museum includes, but is not limited to, exterior masonry cleaning, repointing, repair, sealing, and water repellent coating. Work on Straub Hall includes, but is not limited to exterior masonry restoration and sealing, sheet metal restoration, exterior wood trim restoration, exterior window restoration, stucco repair, adhered elastic sheet roofing installation, and exterior painting.
