In the last four years millions of ing--as well as inspiring in a controverpeople have seen Spike Lee's films and have read the companion books--Spike Lee's Gotta Have It, Uplift the Race, and Do the Right Thing (which, by the way, can all be found in the Portland library), Receiving notoriety with the

success of each film, he has caused a stir in the film industry both behind and in front of the camera.

With "She's Gotta Have It' (1986), he won an award for best new director at the Cannes Film Festival and "School Daze'' (1988), was a financial success, receiving an enormous amount of media attention due to its controversial

message. But it was "Do the Right Thing" (1989), that really pushed his name and talent to the forefront of American filmmaking. Now, he is considered one of the most exciting, innovative, and thought provoksial sense--Black film directors around

His upcoming movie, Mo' Better Blues (the title stems from what one of Spike's ex-girlfirends dubbed "the nasty": "the mo' better"), features a






