## NEW ROLE FOR RELIGIONS- WINNING THE WAR ON DRUGS

The fight against drugs has a new army of warriors-churches

The National Council of Churches is planning a summit conference in Washington, DC, this fall, the first time in its history that the leaders of its 32 member bodies have been called together to map out an assault against drug and alcohol abuse.

The United Methodists have appointed a bishop full time on a one year special "drug-busting" assignment.

And instead of sitting passively by or turning the other cheek as their cities are torn apart by drug use, Church members are actively forcing drug pushers out of housing projects and neighborhoods and bringing programs directly to addicts in these areas.

The Church battle against drugs covers a broad range of functions--

from the Methodist "saving stations," which offer a variety of anti-drug programs around the clock. The Church of Scientology has launched city, state and nation-wide campaigns, such as Lead the Way to a Drug Free USA, donated educational materials to libraries, given lectures to hundreds of thousands of parents and children, and spearheaded many other programs. Scientologists have gotten more than 100,000 people off drugs.

In large part because of these activities, there is growing evidence that the public are recognizing that religions have an important role in society.

In what the Los Angeles Times called "a new chapter in its history, one that has attracted a new generation of supporters," spiritual leaders of other religions are launching programs that cut through bureaucratic red tape and maintenance programs that don't work, with fresh new approaches.
