The five hour festival took place at Pioneer Square, and was free of charge. It featured colorful African dress, as well as engera--traditional African food--served by the Portland chapter of the Eritrean Relief Committee, as a fund raiser for Eritrea Ethiopian refugees.

The event also featured Obo Addy and his band Okropong, playing African music and performing traditional dances.
