Lucies C. Ellison was born July 19, 1905 to Alex and Frances Ford-Ellison. He was the second of nine children. Known to all as L.C. or "Baby" Ellison, he lived a full Christian life. Brother Ellison was ordained as a deacon in Warren, Arkansas at the Third Baptist Church in 1933 by the late Rev. W.H. Watson.

He married Rosie Bowie on June 26, 1939 and later moved to Portland in 1942. After moving to Portland, they united with the Community Church in Vanport under the late Rev. Booker Carey.

Brother Ellison lived an active life, participating in various lodges and organizations. He held the Treasurer position for the Billy Webb Lodge #1050 I.B.P.O.E.W. for 40 years, he was also a lifetime member of the N.A.A.C.P., was a member and held offices in the Enterprise Lodge #1 F&HA, Willamette Consistory #23, Minor Temple #68, Commander of the Rite PHA of Oregon, as well as the Urban League of Portland. He also served as a Portland Police Reserve and was promoted as high as Lieutenant. He was one of the Police Officers that escorted Dr. Martin Luther King upon his visit to Portland during the 1960's.

His very active life came to an end on November 23, 1990. He leaves to mourn his homegoing: his loving wife of 51 years, Rosie Ellison, a brother, Woodrow of San Francisco, California; two sisters, Catherine York of San Francisco, and Flossie Cable of Portland, Oregon.

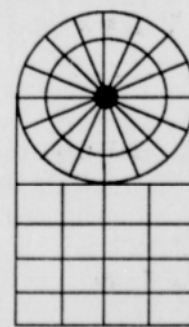
