Anxiety and Depression Associated with Chronic Stomach Aches in Children

Although recurrent abdominal pain affects approximately 12 percent of school-aged children, only 10 percent of those affected have an identifiable medical problem. The other children are often assumed to be suffering from emotional problems such as anxiety and depression. To determine whether these children have more emotional problems than other youngster, NICHD-supported investigators at Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee compared them to children with physical diagnoses for their stomach pain, children with psychiatric disturbances, and healthy controls. An increased incidence of emotional problems-primarily anxiety and depressionwas found in both the children with a medical diagnosis for their abdominal pain an those without. Further testing is needed to determine the relation between the emotional and physiological symptoms found in children with recurrent abdominal pain.
