

The owner and mortgage holder of the house at 4905 N. Vancouver Ave. have agreed to release their interests in the property at a nominal cost, if we pay all taxes and liens on that land. That means we should be able to purchase clear title to the land for a little over \$8,000. Costs to make a down payment on the house at 4906 N. Gantenbein are still about \$750.


