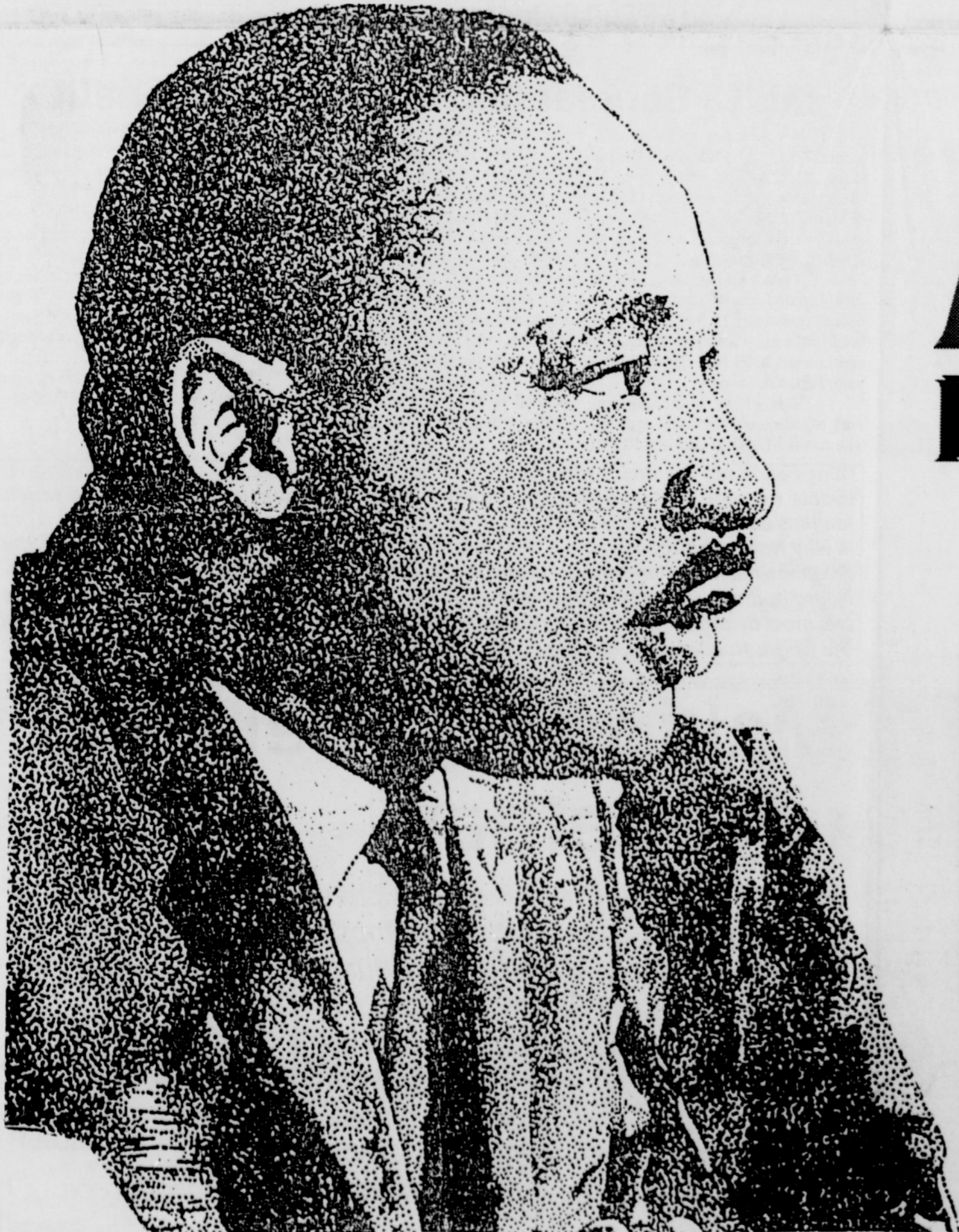

A LEADER SPEAKS:

"Along with the struggle to desegregate, we must engage in the struggle for better jobs. The same system that exploits the Negro exploits the poor White man. The White power structure hollers n--.n--.n-- while exploiting both poor Whites and Negroes."

"The emergency we now face is economic, and it is a desperate and worsening situation.... This is no time for apathy or complacency. This is a time for vigorous and positive action."
