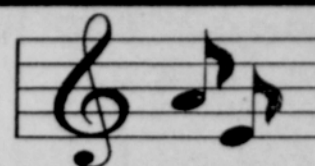

A&E Presents "Biography: Jackie Robinson"



Arts & Entertainment Network (A & E) continues its fifth successful season of BIOGRAPHY with the world Premiere of an A & E/CEL Communications co-production, JACKIE ROBINSON on Tuesday, April 16, 1991 at 8 pm and 12 midnight, ET. This documentary on the life and times of baseball's courageous pioneer is hosted and narrated by Peter Graves.

Jackie Robinson was an all-star college athlete in baseball, football, basketball and track. With his dramatic entrance into professional baseball in 1947, he broke the sport's color barrier and by his very presence turned the National League into a forum for the civil rights movement. From his struggles against injustice in the military through his civil rights marches with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Jackie Robinson was an American hero whose accomplishments went far beyond the ballpark.
