April 30th was the last day to legally have studded snow tires on your vehicles. They will not become legal again until November 1, 1991.



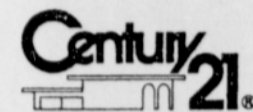

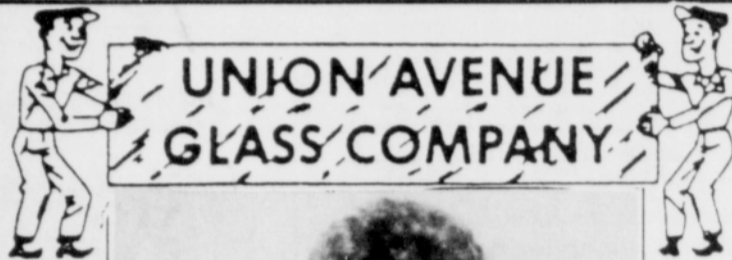
