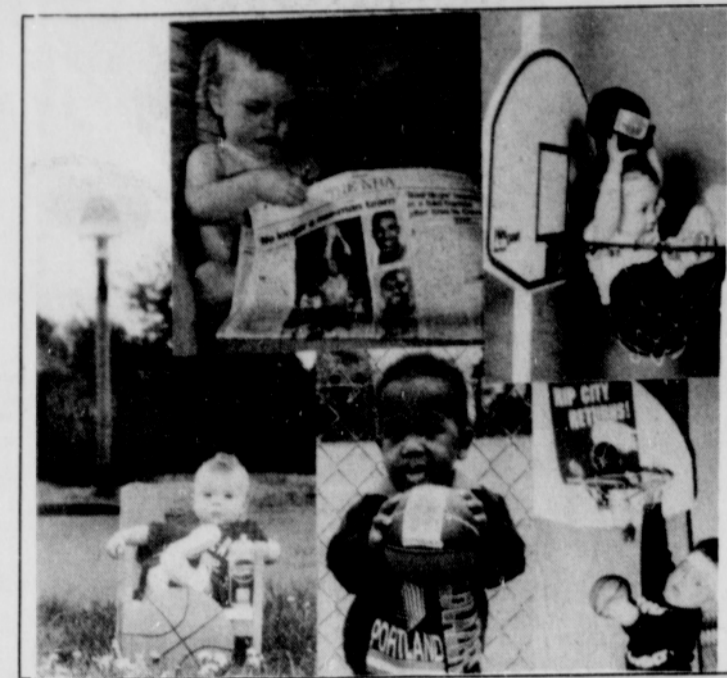

## 15,000 Black Jews Return 'Home'; New "Wings Over Ethiopia" (Isaiah 18:1) (Part I)

The Falashas, or Negro Jews of Ethiopia, led by Queen Judith, put the line of Solomon and the Queen of Sheba off the throne of Ethiopia in 937 A.D., and ruled for forty years. The Falashas assert that they are the original Jews. They call themselves "The Beta-Israel," or "The Chosen People."

W.E.B. DuBois (The World And Africa): In Greek legend, Ethiopia, "land of the burnt faces," lay either side of the Red Sea in Africa and Asia and was inhabited by black folk. Eventually the blacks mixed with yellow Asiatics. After the fifth and fourth centuries B.C. the term Ethiopia was used usually to designate regions in Africa corresponding to what we now know as Nubia or the Egyptian Sudan. The Sudan was known to the Egyptians and Hebrews as Kash or Cush. In Hebrew folklore the descendants of Ham "were Cush and Egypt."

Smith (A Dictionary of the Bible, 1865): If we examine the invaluable ethnography of Genesis (Gen.ix.18,x.6.15-20) there would seem to be no reason to doubt as to the Hamitic origin of these tribes...while Ham is the brother of Shem...the Hamites are described as those who previously occupied the different countries into which the Aramaean races afterwards forced their way. Thus scripture attributes to the race of Ham not only the aboriginal population of Canaan, with its wealthy and civilized communities on the coast, but also the mighty empires of Babylon and Nineveh, the rich kingdoms of Sheba and Havilah in Arabia Felix, and the wonderful realm of Egypt.

The facts above are just a little part of the testimony from the most noted and accepted historians in the field. The last citation, from Smith, one of the most erudite Biblical scholars and archaeologists of the "19th century", was a white Englishman (William Smith, L.L.D., Classical Examiner in the University of London and editor of the Dictionaries of Greek and Roman Antiquities). This invokes an interesting commentary. Until the latter half of the century, one finds for the most part, a rather factual and truthful account of African presence throughout the ancient world, and of the ethnicity of key actors in the formation of civilization (especially in Europe whose nations restricted African slavery to their colonies).

But by the end of that century there had developed a vicious process for RACIST REVISIONISM OF HISTORY which quickly spread to America. Interestingly, it was coincident with the growing attacks upon the intellectual capacities of darker races; "I.Q."-even upon southern and Slavic Europeans as demonstrated by the related tightening of U.S. Immigration Codes. This process had continued until today with a number of Biblical 'scholars' busy at producing rewrites and new versions of the 'Good Book'. Not noticed by many have been their determined efforts to conceal or obliterate the predominate African presence by renaming tribes and languages, and by gerrymandering geography. Even as late as my youth, whites consistently patronized older black men with a white beard like mine by addressing them as "MOSES"-and

we know from our grandparents that blacks, themselves, named children after Biblical characters.

Common sense had led them to the inference that if only a few hundred "Hebrews" were taken into captivity in Africa proper, and a fairly short time later 12,000 souls departed for home in the Exodus (taking along the Pharaohs silverware" "Spoil The Egyptians"-then undoubtedly, EVERYONE CONCERNED WAS BLACK! I can still remember police investigating burglaries in the ghetto, "I know you niggers (sic) steal. You made off with the Pharaohs' dinnerware, didn't you." Earlier, you see, there was little doubt as to who those "wooly-headed" prophets, preachers and warriors were, as well as the knaves you find in any race.

While we evaluate the preponderance of evidence for the early African presence in the "Semite" lands, we should consider some very revealing aspects of that "Dictionary of the Bible". Generally, wherever there is an illustration or description of a technology or domestic artifact used in ancient Israel, it is seen to be African in nature or derivation (Egyptian/Ethiopian / Sudan). The same is true with many other texts. A classic example is the famed hand mirrors made in the exact form of the Egyptian "Ankh", symbol of life, or the wine presses, or brick-making, or gold mining. Then, too, there are the standards of measurements like the "cubit", imported directly from Ethiopia and Egypt (Solomons Temple-Noahs's Ark).

More revelations next week: Nimrod, reed boats, Cush, Candace, etc.

## Its Time To Cutback Tall Grass And Weeds

May 1st through September the Bureau of Buildings Neighborhood Inspection Section will increase inspections on Tall Grass and weeds. If you own or manage property in the City of Portland or rent with an agreement to maintain the property it is your responsibility to ensure that the property is maintained at a level that meets the city code.

Failure to meet these requirements could result in the Bureau contracting to have the work done for you. If this is done a civil penalty could be imposed along with a lien for the contractors fee.

Give your neighbor a gentle reminder that it's time to cut back their grass and weeds. The bureau will take complaints if you call 796-7306 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Please keep in mind that when enforcement is increased so are complaints.
