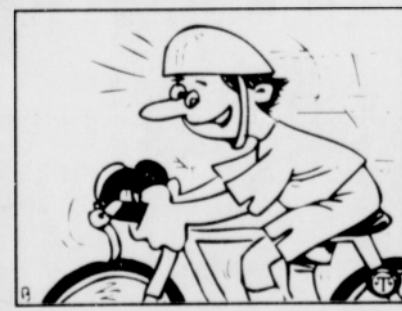

Whether you drive a car or a bicycle, you're a lot safer thanks to the ways plastics are used. In your car, the safety may be behind the wheel. An air bag, made from specially coated nylon, remains folded under the plastic hub of the steering wheel until a significant frontal impact. In less than 1/20th of a second from the time of impact, the bag is fully deployed and can prevent the driver from hitting the steering wheel or dashboard.

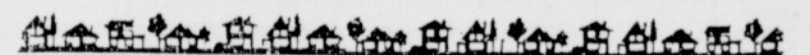


Plastic helmets also protect bicyclists from injury. The helmets are generally made from expanded polystyrene foam (plastic) and covered with either cloth or a hard outer plastic shell. According to the National Safety Council, 75 percent of the more than 14,000 fatalities annually involving bicycles and automobiles can be avoided if bicyclists wear proper head protection.

Here's another safety fact to drink in: reinforced plastic towers are used to purify water. In DelRay Beach, Florida, 57-foot high towers are used to strip out organic compounds that contaminated much of the city's water supply. Because the towers are made from reinforced plastic, they will not corrode from contact with the compounds and they will withstand harsh coastal salt air.
