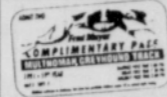

1991 Jefferson Summer Baseball a Big Success

Jefferson baseball returned to the winning ways of old as the school's summer team compiled a 17-10-1 record, which included a 12-game winning streak that was finally stopped in an exciting 9 inning game against Southwest Portland.

Scott Ziegler won seven games pitching and Joe Robertson, Sedric Ford, Anthony Green, Hakeem McAllister, Benny Thompson, Jayson Warren, and Suntory Robertson made big contributions with the bat and glove. All players, with the exception of Sedric Ford—who will attend Grambling in the fall, will return to the varsity school team in the spring. Joe Robertson, Sedric Ford, and Mark Burke Jr., who attend Cleveland High School but who will continue to play Jefferson Summer Baseball, all hit over 500 and together hit 10 home runs. Scott Gall, Jeff Coryell, and Aaron Wilder also made important contributions to the team. Three players from Benson High School (Brian Cunningham, Steve Moloney, and Ryan Estes) rounded out the Jefferson All-Stars roster, and were a big part of Jeff's winning ways.

The summer team was organized by coach Mark Burke and was later joined by coach Willie Grant, who helped instill in the team a positive attitude and fighting spirit. The team was financed through individual contributions and currently needs further financial assistance. Coach Burke is the varsity baseball coach at Jefferson and he can be contacted at the school.

The last three games were played at the Senior Babe Ruth State Tournament (16-18 year olds) at Tigard High School. Jefferson won one and lost two, and competed hard through the tournament.

One of the hallmarks of the 1991 team was its togetherness and unity, as exemplified in the good sportsmanship displayed through the entire schedule.

In the years to come, coaches Burke and Grant plan to build a baseball powerhouse at Jefferson and they call on the community to support Jefferson baseball.
