

Cascade Vision Center Offers Affordable Eye Care

Pacific University College of Optometry opened its community based family vision center about six years ago in Northeast Portland. Known as the Cascade Vision Center, it's located on the Portland Community College Cascade Campus at 600 N. Killingsworth Street. The clinic's main purpose is to provide low-cost eve care for people in need. The services at the clinic are not free but the cost can be tailored to fit your budget.

Heading up the clinic is Katherine Hinshaw, D.O., a graduate of Pacific University College of Optometry, the only college of its kind in the Northwest. The students who work at the clinic are capable and well trained under the direction of Katherine Hinshaw. Dr. Hinshaw takes great pride in providing eye care such as free screening for all ages in ordr to determine what a patients eye care

The Vision Center determines a patient's ability to pay for the services according to individual or family income. The clinic does have a minimum pay level for services and most patients receive some fee adjustment due to limited income.

This is a fine program that needs to be utilized by the community. If your eye care problems cannot be treated at the Cascade Vision Center, the college has two other centers within their own system that they can refer patients to.

Dr. Hinshaw notes the Cascade Family Vision Center is currently open Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during regular business hours, and that the clinic will add a fourth day of operation beginning this fall. Director of Community Rela-


