The successful candidate will:

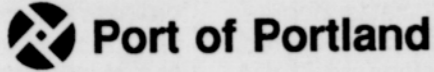
- Plan, supervise, and coordinate the block building, docking, and undocking of vessels.

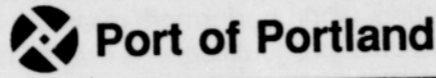

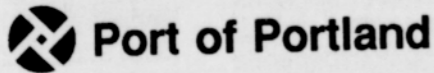

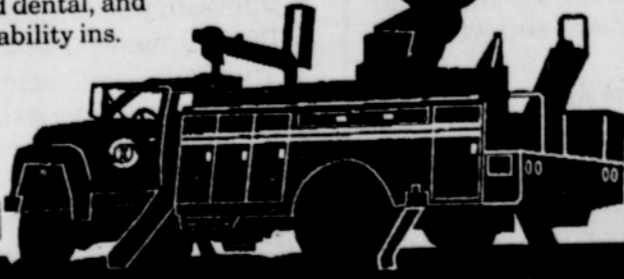
