## Holyfield Says Lack of Education Causes Prejudice

"Prejudice is just lack of education," declared Evander Holyfield, adding, "We can always find something to do as long as we have an education."

In an interview to be published this Sunday in PARADE magazine, the heavyweight champion of the world declared, "I just like to help people the best way I can. Whenever I speak at schools, I talk about the value of education. That's why I say the most important role model is not the heavyweight champion of the world or the champion home-run hitter, but the parents who's active in the PTA."

"Everybody looks at me like an athlete, but I always stress the importance of education and not making your mark as an athlete. You have to make education count."

Evander, who said he'd like to be a sports agent after he retires from the ring, noted, "There are maybe 300 athletes in the country who make the really big money. But there are probably 3 million who never make that kind of money but who need the education. Education is knowledge. Maybe I could advise them, help them plan their futures."

Evander, who was an indifferent student, according to his mother, Annie, managed to get through high school. He now pays close attention to the report cards of his two girls and two boys.
