1929-1968

Portland's Highland Elementary School
was renamed for the late Martin Luther
King in 1968 — without surveys or
other red tape.

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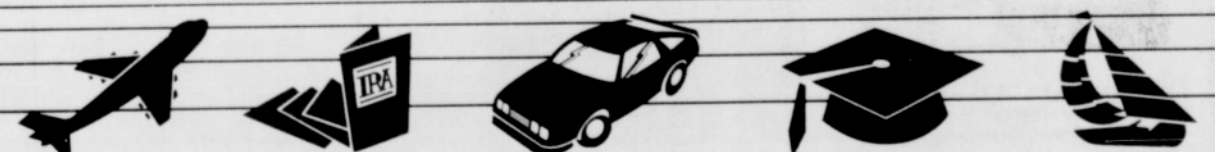
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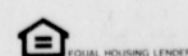
